Application for Membership

QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP

No candidate shall be elected who is under the age of 18 years.

A candidate may be elected to membership of the Club by the Committee when proposed and seconded by two existing Members or the Membership Committee.

In considering a candidate's application for membership, it is intended that the Committee will take into account all factors that would indicate the candidate's qualifications for Membership, such as:

- *Being of direct Scottish descent.*
- *Being the son or daughter of a Member.*
- *Being born in Scotland.*
- *Being employed by a major industrial, commercial or professional business in Scotland.*
- *Being closely associated with a multi-national employer's Scottish interests.*
- *Having been educated in Scotland or having a recognised Scottish professional qualification.*
- *Being a Scottish landowner.*
- *Having been resident in Scotland for at least five years.*
- *Having played a significant role in Scottish public life in Government, the Armed Services, Charitable Bodies or Academia.*
- *Being married to or in a civil partnership with a Scot.*

The interpretation and application of this Rule is solely at the discretion of the Committee.

CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP

Town: A Town Member is a Member who has a permanent residential address within a 50 mile radius by rail from a London terminus.

Country: A Country Member is a Member who has a permanent residential address outside a 50 mile radius by rail from a London terminus, who has no permanent residential address within that limit and has notified the Secretary in writing to this effect.

Overseas: An Overseas Member is a Member whose permanent residential address is outside the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man.

THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS

Proposers and seconders are encouraged to introduce their candidate to other Members of the Club at the earliest opportunity and gain support for their candidate.

Following the submission of a fully completed application form and full supporting letters from the Proposer and seconder, the application will go before the Membership Committee for consideration. At this stage a candidate may be asked to attend an interview with the Membership Committee.

At the next stage, upon initial approval, the candidate's name is displayed on the Club noticeboard for a minimum of two weeks. This will give any Members who have met the candidate, and who approve of the application, the opportunity to add their signature of support or otherwise. The application will then go to the Committee for final consideration.

Proposers & Seconders

This section is to be completed by the Candidate's sponsors who must be personally acquainted with, and shall be responsible for, the eligibility of their Candidate. The sponsors should also have appraised the Candidate fully of the Club's Rules, Bye-Laws and traditions.

In order for the application to be considered, this form must be returned together with a letter from both the Proposer and the Secunder, each explaining from personal experience why they feel the candidate is eligible and suitable for membership of the Club, in accordance with the Membership Committee's aide memoire. Whilst the application form covers certain details about the Candidate, these letters are used by the Membership Committee to provide a more personal picture of the Candidate.
